Electronic payments will be made on the 12th of each month or the first business day thereafter.

The amount of the electronic payment will be the monthly tuition amount shown on your statement. The June payment will be to balance your account and might be a different amount than previous months. If too much was paid, you will receive a refund check. **If too little was paid the balance will be added to the June payment.** This electronic tuition payment schedule will be in effect for the entire school year unless special circumstances dictate otherwise.
