- NCAA/NAIA Clearinghouse




Tasks for Junior Year

College Readiness Testing



PSAT

Determines National Merit Scholar Candidate

Optional test (good test-prep, especially for SAT)

October 14 during school (cost = FREE)

Coaching available (cost = \$45)--9/22, 9/29, 10/6 from 7:00-8:30 pm

Sign-up DEADLINE is Sept 18

Sign-up with Mrs. Jonkman in main office

ACT or SAT



College Entrance Exams

ONE (not both) is required for college entrance

ACT offered April 17 @ ICHS (cost = \$50-\$60). Other dates available at www.act.org

ACT coaching offered by ICHS teachers or Excel Edge. Cost & Dates--TBD later this fall.

College/Career Visits



- Juniors & seniors may take 2 visit days during both junior & senior years
 - 1st sem, visit days must be <u>BEFORE Christmas break</u>
 - 2nd sem, visit days must be <u>BEFORE May 1</u>
- Work/tests must be made up within 3 school days of returning to school
- To request a visit day:
 - Complete the College/Career Visit form & turn it into the office <u>PRIOR</u> to the visit. <u>GREEN form</u> is on the wall across from the main office.
 - Bring back College/Career Visit Verification form <u>AFTER</u> visit & turn it in to the office. <u>YELLOW form</u> is on the wall across from the main office.



4-Year College Bound Students

- Check college websites for <u>ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS</u> (Undergrad, 1st Year Student, Freshman)
 - Colleges have different deadlines for their applications, but in general, Aug 1 Nov 1 is considered a "Priority Filing Period." This DOES NOT include all colleges. However, if it includes your intended college, you may lose scholarship money if you apply after this time or may not be admitted if all spots are filled!!

Examples of Priority Deadlines (Early Action)

• Purdue (Lafayette) Nov 1 (Jan 15 = regular deadline)

• Indiana Univ Nov 1 (Feb 1 = regular deadline)

○ Ball State Univ
Nov 15 for honors college

• Univ of Illinois Nov 1 (Dec 1 = regular deadline)

• ISU/NIU/DePaul Nov 15



College Admission Requirements

VISIT colleges you're considering attending (go to college's website to find out visit day info)

4-Year Bound Students

- Think about 2 teachers/staff to write a <u>LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION</u> (form in GC under 4-Year College, Letters of Recommendation)
- Take <u>ACT or SAT</u> test (GC under ACT/SAT Testing Info section)
- Check with the college you plan to attend about its policy on AP/DUAL CREDIT
- Use the <u>JUNIOR COLLEGE CALENDAR</u> to keep track of your next steps (GC under 4-year & then College Applications section)
- Parents/guardians should attend the VIRTUAL FINANCIAL AID SEMINAR on SEPTEMBER 21st at 7:00 pm
