Dear Juniors and Parents,

Junior year is an important one as students are becoming more serious about making post-high school plans. Many of Illiana's students are considering colleges and hoping for scholarships. One of the steps in that process is taking the ACT test. The ACT is used by almost all colleges as a factor in admission decisions and scholarship awards. The best way to prepare for the ACT is to take challenging core coursework as there is a strong correlation between the rigorous core courses and high performance on the ACT.

The ACT will be offered at Illiana on April 17, 2021. However, students may register to take the test on a different date. To register and to search for additional test dates, go to www.act.org. As part of the registration process, be sure to use Illiana's school code, 154444, so the test results can be included on students' transcripts.

The counselors strongly encourage students to take the test at least twice because students are often able to improve their scores. For example, students may want to take the test in April and again in June or July after they have received their initial scores and have completed junior year. Often, colleges will look at the highest scores in each of the subcategories and take that information into consideration when making admission and scholarship decisions.

Illiana is again offering juniors a four-night ACT preparation program presented by our own teachers in the four areas of ACT testing—math, reading, English, and science. The dates for this program are March 18, 23, 25, and April 6 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The teachers involved are Mr. Lagerwey, Mr. DeVries and Mr. Sylvester. This program will give participants a refresher in content and valuable test taking strategies that we believe will improve their ACT performance. The sign-up deadline is January 15, 2021. The cost is \$50 and must be paid in advance by check or cash. Students are not able to charge this fee to their tuition. They can register in the office.

As in previous years, we will also use a company called ExcelEdge to offer test preparation. This company has done an excellent job in the past preparing our students for the ACT. Additional information how to sign up for ExcelEdge coaching and the dates are in the accompanying letter from their company.
