- **ATTENTION PARENTS OF EIGHTH GRADERS:** High School is just around the corner for many of you! We are now accepting online applications for the 2023 2024 academic year. Current Illiana families can access the application in their Family Portal under Apply/Enroll. New families should visit the Admissions page on the Illiana website. Please pass this information on to friends and family.
- **RE-ENROLLMENT FEES for the 2024-2025** of \$165 were added to your February tuition statements. You will <u>not</u> need to fill out a separate re-enrollment. If your student will not be returning next year, please notify Jenna Dutton. Families will still need to complete the course request forms through ParentsWeb as directed by the counselors.
- Also, since we do not get "fresh" information from re-enrollment, **please make any updates in address, phone number, etc.,** through your Family Portal. To make updates, log in to your School > Web Forms > Family Demographic Form.

COUNSELING OFFICE:

- **SCHOOL-WIDE TESTING** will take place March 12-14, 2024. There have been some changes to the SAT Suite of Assessments such as the tests are shorter, digital, and have fewer questions. To provide the best testing environment for students, we will not administer all of the assessments in one day. Students will test as follows and return to class once they are completed. Seniors are expected to be in school during testing.
- Freshmen will take the PSAT 8/9 on March 12
- Sophomores will take the PSAT 10 on March 13
- Juniors will take the SAT on March 14. More information regarding the SAT can be found below.
- The SAT test will be offered at Illiana Christian High School on Thursday, March 14, 2024 for Illiana students only. Indiana requires ALL juniors to take the SAT as part of graduation requirements. Students do not need to pay or register for the test on this date. In addition to meeting a graduation requirement, the results from this test can also be used for students' college entrance exam scores.

• NEW & REQUIRED!!! FAFSA (Free Application for Financial Aid)

During 2023, Indiana passed a law that **REQUIRES ALL** high school seniors, regardless of future plans, either to file the FAFSA **OR** to opt out of filing by April 15, 2024. Completing the FAFSA is an important step in a postsecondary education. Students pursuing short-term certificate training, associate/bachelor's degrees, or participating in some trade school/apprenticeship programs may receive financial aid by completing the FAFSA. Think you may not qualify for financial aid? The federal government has made some changes, so you may qualify after all. An email with more detailed information about this requirement went out to all seniors and their families in November. Another one was sent out in December. Be sure to complete the **23-24 FAFSA Questionnaire** to assist us with the tracking process for the state. **Even those who do not live in Indiana must complete this requirement due to attending an Indiana school**. FROM THE TUITION OFFICE:

INCIDENTAL CHARGES: Your next Incidentals Invoice will be sent on March 5, 2024. Incidental Charges that you will see on that invoice:

- **Re-enrollment Fee:** All Freshman-Junior students will be automatically re-enrolled for the 2024-2025 school year. A fee of \$165 per student will be added to your Incidental Invoice. Please note: you will then receive a \$100 enrollment fee credit on your first tuition statement of the 24-25 school year. If you need to make changes to your child's enrollment, please contact Jenna Dutton at jdutton@illianachristian.org.
- A **SPIRE fee** of \$68 will be added to your Incidental Invoice IF your child placed an order. If there is NO yearbook charge on your invoice, then an order was not placed. To change your child's order, please email Kathy West at <u>kwest@illianachristian.org</u>. Please note, yearbooks may also be purchased the night of the next year's SPIRE party at the door for \$80.

PIE FEES & CREDITS: <u>NEW THIS YEAR!!</u> The annual PIE fee of \$250 will now be billed in May ONLY to families who have NOT completed their volunteer hours. If you have completed all of your PIE volunteer hours by May, you will simply not be charged. If you have completed some of your volunteer hours, you will only be billed for what you have not worked off. As the year comes to a close, any hours that are worked in May/June will be credited to your account weekly.
