TESTING: Students who are in a biology class this year will be taking the state-mandated ILEARN Biology test. The results of this test are shared with students, their families, Illiana, and the state of Indiana. Scores are used for school accountability and curriculum purposes only. The ILEARN Biology test is on May 7th.

CURRENT ILLIANA FAMILIES! Do you have an incoming freshman? If the answer is yes, and you haven't done so already, NOW is time to fill out Illiana's admission application. All incoming freshmen are required to fill out the online application and enrollment packet. - -Application Instructions: Current Illiana families can access the application in their ParentsWeb/Family Portal under Apply/Enroll and start a new application. (Remember, current Illiana students do not need to fill out an application.) New families should visit the Admissions page on the Illiana website.
- -After you have submitted your student's application, you will need to enroll them by completing the online enrollment packet. Instructions for completing this packet will be emailed to you once the application for admission is submitted.

FROM THE BUSINESS OFFICE

PARENTS OF SENIORS: Please be reminded of the tuition payment policy from the handbook regarding graduation as seen below. Be sure that you are up-to-date on tuition and incidentals payments before May 31 to ensure that your senior is able to participate in graduation.

From the Handbook: "5. A senior may participate in graduation if their family's tuition account is paid in full through May 31st. This will then leave only the June payment."

2024 - 2025 TUITION:

• The tuition rate for the 2024-2025 school year is \$12,815.00. This breaks down to \$1165/month due from August-June. A \$100 enrollment fee credit will be reflected on your tuition agreement at the beginning of the year. More information will be sent early this summer via email with specific tuition agreements, Voucher credits, and monthly payment amounts so that you can plan for next year.
